

Blueprint Ministries Liability Release and Behavior Guidelines for Building Use

We are so excited you are going to stay at Blueprint Ministries. As an overnight guest, we ask that you read the below Behavior Guidelines & Liability Release information and **bring the signed signature page with you when you come.** * **Guests, under 18 years of age, must have a parent or legal guardian complete the signature portion of the form or will not be permitted to stay overnight in our building.**

Alcohol, Tobacco and Drug Policy

Guests must refrain from the illegal possession, use, or distribution of non-medical drugs or medicinal drugs in any form either on or off campus. Guests must also refrain from the possession or use of any alcoholic or tobacco products in any form.

Property Misusage

Blueprint property should be respected at all times. All participants in acts of vandalism, including spectators, may be held financially responsible for damage. Elevators should be used only if physically needed or for loading luggage.

Sports of any kind are not permitted inside building including running throughout the building. This includes bouncing or throwing a ball, throwing a Frisbee, skateboarding, use of water balloons, squirt guns, or water fights.

Restrictions

Males are prohibited from going onto the 3rd floor-Female Dorms. Females are not allowed anywhere on the 2nd floor except in the game room. No males or females are allowed in dorm rooms of the opposite sex.

All exterior doors are to remain closed except in an emergency.

No candles or open flames allowed.

Weapon Policy

Weapons of any kind, including but not limited to, handguns, rifles, shotguns, other firearms, knives, stun guns/lasers, potato cannons, paintball guns, pellet or BB guns, airsoft guns, martial arts weaponry, bows, slingshots, and any other devices used in game or sporting activities, including ammunition, arrows, or other types of projectiles associated with such items, are prohibited,
